### News from KS1

#### Key Stage 1 Weaving Project Trip to The East Quay

As part of our exciting Weaving Project, Key Stage 1 had a wonderful opportunity to visit The East Quay for a day of creativity and discovery.

Our first stop was the Boat Museum, where the children learned how weaving has traditionally been used in fishing. They explored different materials and techniques before making their own twine, just like fishermen have done for generations.

The highlight of the day was having a go at weaving themselves! The children made cosy woolly jumpers for sheep and experimented with weaving using a variety of materials on small looms. It was fantastic to see their creativity and enthusiasm shine through.

The trip brought our learning to life and gave the children valuable hands-on experiences that deepened their understanding of weaving, materials and traditional crafts. We are incredibly proud of how engaged and curious they were throughout the day.

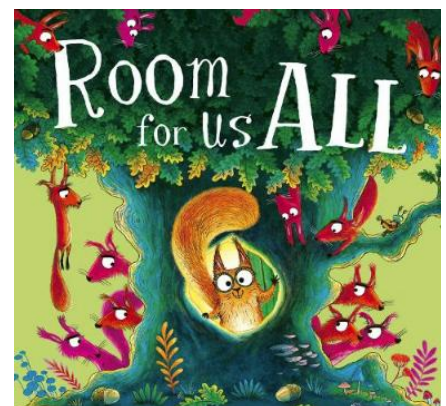

### My Happy Mind – Relate

This week, our focus has been on the Relate module, where children have been learning about the importance of building positive relationships and being a supportive friend.

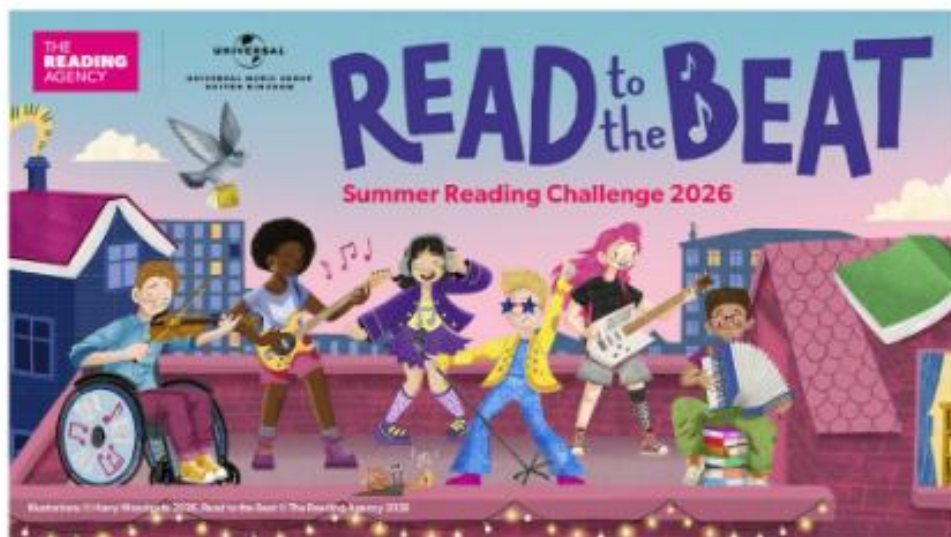
